



1st–4th grade Pupil Satisfaction Survey Autumn 2019

Oslo City Council has decided to conduct a Student Satisfaction Survey for the oldest children in kindergarten and for all first to fourth grade primary school pupils. The aim of the survey is to provide the youngest pupils with the opportunity to express their feelings about different aspects of the school environment. The survey will provide schools with valuable knowledge to assist them in their work in creating a good and safe school environment that promotes health, well-being and learning.

The survey will be conducted at all primary schools with first to fourth grade pupils from **15 October to 15 December 2019.**

Survey contents

The survey contains 16 questions. The questions concern the topics of well-being, support from adults at school, friendship and play, as well as involvement. There will also be two questions about homework at some selected schools.

Survey implementation

The survey will be carried out electronically with a visual design and read-aloud function adapted to the target group. The pupils will complete the survey on a tablet or PC. The school will ensure that pupils can complete the survey independently, without assistance from an adult.

If, in the event of special needs, a pupil is unable to complete the survey independently, the school will make provision for the pupil to express his/her feelings about well-being in dialogue with the pupil and his/her parents/guardians.

Privacy

The survey is anonymous. Responses cannot be traced to individual pupils. No reports will be made on an individual level. Rambøll Management Consulting administers the Pupil Satisfaction Survey on behalf of Oslo Municipality (the data controller). Following data collection, reports will be made on a municipal, school and group/class level. The regulations of the Norwegian Directorate of Education and Training regarding the anonymization of survey results will be followed.

Consent and participation

The child's participation in the survey is voluntary. This means that parents/guardians may request that their child does not participate in the survey prior to the start of the survey.
